No. 13 of 1932.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Administration and Probate
Ordinance 1929-1930.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1931, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1932. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1930 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Administration and Probate Ordinance* 1929-1932.

2. Section five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after the definition of "Prescribed", the following definition:— Definitions.

"'Probate' includes 'exemplification of probate' or any other formal document, purporting to be under the seal of a court of competent jurisdiction, which, in the opinion of the Court, is deemed sufficient;".

3. Section seventy of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "a Justice or the Registrar" and inserting in their stead the words "or a Justice". Executors, &c., may be allowed commission.

4. Section ninety-two of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (3.), after the word "Court", the words "or a Justice". Distribution of assets by curator.

5. Section ninety-three of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the word "Court", the words "or a Justice". Notice of order to be published.

6. Section ninety-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting, after the word "Court", the words "or a Justice".
