## AN ORDINANCE

### To amend the Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1938.

**B**E it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909-1938* and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1940*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1943*.<sup>\*</sup>

(2.) The *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1938*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1943*.

2. Section twenty-eight of the *Rabbit Destruction Ordinance 1919-1938* is amended by omitting the word “thirty-one” and inserting in its stead the word “thirty-three”.

Duties of owners and occupiers to destroy rabbits and noxious animals.
