EDUCATION ORDINANCE 1958.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Education* Short title and citation.

(2.) The Education Ordinance 1937-1956, \dagger as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Education Ordinance 1937-1958.

2. Section five of the *Education Ordinance* 1937-1956 is _{Definitions.} amended by omitting the definition of "the Court" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

"' the Court' has the same meaning as in the Child Welfare Ordinance 1957;".
