## CITY AREA LEASES ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the City Area Leases Ordi- Short title nance (No. 2) 1976.\*

- (2) The City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1975,† as amended by the City Area Leases Ordinance 1976,‡ is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) Section 1 of the City Area Leases Ordinance 1976 is amended by omitting sub-section (3).
- (4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1976.
  - 2. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—
    - (a) by omitting from sub-section (12) the words "An invite amount" and substituting the words "Subject to sub- applications for leases. section (13), an amount "; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:— "(13) Where a person who becomes the successful applicant for the right to the grant of a lease fails to comply with sub-section (6), (7) or (9), an amount lodged by way of deposit with the application made by that person under this section is, by force of this sub-section, forfeit to the Commonwealth."
