To amend the *Unclaimed Moneys Ordinance 1950*.

UNCLAIMED MONEYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1976

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Unclaimed Moneys (Amendment) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title.

2. Section 4 of the *Unclaimed Moneys Ordinance 1950*[†] is amended by omitting from sub-section (4) the words "Department of the Treasury" and substituting the words "Department of Finance". Unclaimed assets in hands of liquidator.
