## LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1976

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Amend- Short title. ment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1976.\*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Legal Principal Practitioners Ordinance 1970,†
- 3. Section 6L of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Part to the word and figures "1 January 1977" and substituting the word expire on and figures "1 July 1977".
- 4. Section 4 of the Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance Repeal. 1976 is repealed.
- 5. On and after 1 July 1977, the *Interpretation Ordinance* 1967 Part ID to has effect in relation to the provisions of Part ID of the Principal be deemed ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, as if those provisions had 1 July 1977. been repealed on that day by an Ordinance.
