LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1976

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1976*.^{*} Short title.
2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Legal Practitioners Ordinance 1970*.[†] Principal Ordinance.
3. Section 6L of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word and figures "1 January 1977" and substituting the word and figures "1 July 1977". Part to expire on 1 July 1977.
4. Section 4 of the *Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Ordinance 1976* is repealed. Repeal.
5. On and after 1 July 1977, the *Interpretation Ordinance 1967* has effect in relation to the provisions of Part ID of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, as if those provisions had been repealed on that day by an Ordinance. Part ID to be deemed repealed on 1 July 1977.
