### ORDINANCES REVISION (ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS) ORDINANCE 1977

#### PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Ordinances Revision (Administrative Arrangements) Ordinance 1977*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title.

#### PART II—AMENDMENT OF THE ATTACHMENT OF WAGES LIMITATION ORDINANCE 1966

2. Section 3 of the *Attachment of Wages Limitation Ordinance 1966*<sup>†</sup> is repealed. Repeal.

#### PART III—AMENDMENT OF THE AUSTRALIAN-AMERICAN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION ORDINANCE 1966

3. Section 3 of the *Australian-American Educational Foundation Ordinance 1966*<sup>‡</sup> is repealed. Repeal.

#### PART IV—AMENDMENTS OF THE INDUSTRIAL BOARD ORDINANCE 1936

4. In this Part, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Industrial Board Ordinance 1936*.<sup>§</sup> Definition.

5. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Repeal.

- Definitions. **6.** Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the definition of “organization” the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.
- Powers of inspector. **7.** Section 19A of the Principal Ordinance is amended—
- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”;
  - (b) by omitting from sub-section (2) the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”; and
  - (c) by omitting from sub-section (4) the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.
- Regulations. **8.** Section 29 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.
- Savings. **9.** A declaration, appointment or direction made or given by the Attorney-General under a provision of the Principal Ordinance and having force and effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance has the same force and effect after that commencement as it would have had if—
- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the declaration or appointment was made or the direction given, as the case may be; and
  - (b) the declaration, appointment or direction had been made or given by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.

PART V—AMENDMENTS OF THE INSTITUTE FOR THE STUDY OF MAN AND SOCIETY INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 1968

- Repeal. **10.** Section 2 of the *Institute for the Study of Man and Society Incorporation Ordinance* 1968\* is repealed.
- Amendments of Constitution to be made available, &c. **11.** Section 6 of the *Institute for the Study of Man and Society Incorporation Ordinance* 1968 is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.

PART VI—AMENDMENT OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (PROPOSALS FOR UNION WITH OTHER CHURCHES) ORDINANCE 1972

- Regulations. **12.** Section 10 of the *Presbyterian Church (Proposals for Union with other Churches) Ordinance* 1972† is amended by omitting the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.

19. Section 179 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the word "Attorney-General" and substituting the word "Minister".

Regulations.

20. (1) An appointment made under section 7 of the Principal Ordinance and having force and effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance has the same force and effect after that commencement as it would have had if—

Saving.

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the appointment was made; and
- (b) the appointment had been made by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.

(2) Where—

- (a) a design has been notified in the *Gazette* for the purpose of section 8 of the Principal Ordinance; and
- (b) immediately before the date of commencement of this Ordinance the notification of that design had not been revoked,

the notification has effect, on and after that date as if—

- (c) this Ordinance had been in force when the notification was made; and
- (d) the notification had been made by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.

(3) Regulations in force under section 179 of the Principal Ordinance immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance continue in force after that commencement as if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the regulations were made; and
- (b) the regulations had been made by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

#### PART VIII—AMENDMENTS OF THE REAL PROPERTY (CONVERSION OF TITLES) ORDINANCE 1967

Repeal. **21.** Section 2 of the *Real Property (Conversion of Titles) Ordinance* 1967\* is repealed.

Regulations. **22.** Section 26 of the *Real Property (Conversion of Titles) Ordinance* 1967 is amended by omitting the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.

#### PART IX—AMENDMENT OF THE REAL PROPERTY (UNIT TITLES) ORDINANCE 1970

Repeal. **23.** Section 3 of the *Real Property (Unit Titles) Ordinance* 1970† is repealed.

#### PART X—AMENDMENTS OF THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES ORDINANCE 1963

Definition. **24.** In this Part, “Principal Ordinance” means the *Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance* 1963.‡

26. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (4). Registrar and other officers.

27. Section 62 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Repeal.

28. (1) An appointment or determination made by the Attorney-General under the Principal Ordinance and having force and effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance has the same force and effect after that commencement as it would have had if— Saving-

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the appointment or determination was made; and
- (b) the appointment or determination had been made by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

(2) An approval or direction given by the Attorney-General under the Principal Ordinance and having force and effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance has the same force and effect after that commencement as it would have had if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the approval or direction was given; and
- (b) the approval or direction had been given by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance.

#### PART XI—AMENDMENT OF THE REGISTRATION OF DEEDS ORDINANCE 1957

29. (1) Section 3 of the *Registration of Deeds Ordinance 1957*\* is amended by omitting from sub-section (1) the word “Attorney-General” and substituting the word “Minister”. General Register of Deeds.

(2) A direction given by the Attorney-General under sub-section 3 (1) of the *Registration of Deeds Ordinance 1957* and having force and effect immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance has the same force and effect after that commencement as it would have had if—

- (a) this Ordinance had been in operation when the direction was given; and
- (b) the direction had been given by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the *Registration of Deeds Ordinance 1957*, as amended by this Ordinance.

#### PART XII—AMENDMENT OF THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION) ORDINANCE 1930

30. The Second Schedule to the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*† is amended by omitting from Part 1 the following titles:— Second Schedule.
