MOTOR TRAFFIC (ALCOHOL AND DRUGS) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Short title Drugs) (Amendment) Ordinance 1977.*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Motor Principal Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977.†
- 3. Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) "members" and substituting "member".

- 4. Section 25 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Interpretfrom sub-section (3) "discharge" and substituting "discharged".
