GUN LICENCE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gun Licence (Amendment) Short title Ordinance 1978.*
- 2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Gun Principal Ordinance Licence Ordinance 1937.†
 - 3. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

Use, carriage

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) "Twenty dollars" and of gun or substituting "\$100". substituting "\$100";
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2) "Forty dollars" and substituting "\$100"; and
- (c) by omitting from sub-section (3) "One hundred dollars" and substituting "\$500".
- 4. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Gun and sub-section (7) and substituting the following sub-sections: pistol licences

- "(7) The fee payable for the grant or renewal of a gun licence is \$2.
- "(7A) The fee payable for the grant or renewal of a pistol licence is \$15.".

Gun dealer's licence 5. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (3) "Two dollars" and substituting "\$100".
