TERMINATION OF PREGNANCY ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Termination of Pregnancy short title Ordinance 1978.*

2. The Termination of Pregnancy (Temporary Provisions) Ordin- Repeat ance 1977, the Termination of Pregnancy (Temporary Provisions) Ordinance (No. 2) 1977 and the Termination of Pregnancy (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance 1977 are repealed.

3. (1) In this section, "registered medical practitioner" has the Termination same meaning as in the Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance of pregnancy not to be 1930. carried out

(2) A registered medical practitioner shall not carry out treatment certain for the termination of a pregnancy otherwise than at a hospital con-hospitals ducted by the Capital Territory Health Commission.
