REAL PROPERTY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1979

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Real Property (Amendment) Ordinance 1979.1

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Real Property Ordinance 1925.²

Commencement

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 July 1979.

Instrument entitled to priority according to date of registration 4. Section 48 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (4) ", and that instrument when so constructively embodied and stamped with the seal of the Registrar," and substituting "and".

Fees

- 5. Section 139 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2) "and 6" and substituting", 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10".
- 6. Section 168 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following sections are substituted:

Use of prescribed forms

"168. Wherever a document is required, under this Ordinance, to be in accordance with a form in a schedule, a document that is in a form having a like effect to the form in the schedule and that is stamped with, or bears a representation of the imprint of, the seal of the Registrar shall be deemed to be in accordance with the form in the schedule.

"168A. (1) A person shall not cause to be printed a document Document bearing a representation of the imprint of the seal of the Registrar except bearing with the approval of the Registrar.

seal of Registrar

Penalty: \$500.

- "(2) An approval referred to in sub-section (1) shall be in writing and shall specify the contents of the document to which the approval relates and the number of copies of the document that the person may print.".
- 7. Section 169 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting Alteration of from sub-section (1) "every" and substituting "copies of each".
- 8. The Eighteenth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended Eighteenth Schedule by adding at the end thereof the following items:
