HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1980

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1980*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Holidays Ordinance 1958*.²

Public holidays

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (1) (a) (ii) the following sub-paragraph:

"(iia) the third Monday in March (Canberra Day);".
