HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1980

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1980.1

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Holidays Ordinance 1958.²

- 3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (1) (a) (ii) the following sub-paragraph:
 - "(iia) the third Monday in March (Canberra Day);".
