# Machinery (Amendment) Ordinance 1983

An Ordinance to amend the Machinery Ordinance 1949

#### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Machinery (Amendment) Ordinance 1983.

#### Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on 1 October 1983.

#### **Principal Ordinance**

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the Machinery Ordinance 1949.<sup>2</sup>

4. After section 4 of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted:

#### Power of Minister to determine fees

"4A. The Minister may, by notice in writing published in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of this Ordinance.

#### Fees payable

"4B. A fee determined under section 4A is payable to the Commonwealth in relation to the relevant matter specified in the notice referred to in that section, being a matter in respect of which the Minister may make regulations.".

5. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (2) (f).
