An Ordinance to amend the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 5) 1984*.¹

2. Section 145 of the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936*² is repealed and the following section substituted:

Speed limit for heavy vehicles

“145. A person shall not drive a motor vehicle the laden weight of which exceeds 4.5 tonnes, being a motor vehicle other than a motor omnibus, upon a public street at a speed exceeding 80 kilometres per hour.”.
