An Ordinance to amend the Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977

#### **Short title**

**1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs)* (*Amendment) Ordinance 1984*. <sup>1</sup>

#### Conditional release of offenders after conviction

**2.** Section 29 of the *Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Ordinance 1977*<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting all the words from and including "the Court" (first occurring) to and including "may," and substituting "the Court, on an application by the convicted person, may,".
