Low-alcohol Liquor Subsidies Amendment Act 2001

An Act to amend the Low-alcohol Liquor Subsidies Act 2000

[Notified in ACT Gazette No. 21: 24 May 2001] The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Section 1

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Low-alcohol Liquor Subsidies Amendment Act 2001.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the Low-alcohol Liquor Subsidies Act 2000.

5 Operation of Act

- Low-alcohol liquor subsidy is payable, subject to this Act, in relation to sales by wholesale of low-alcohol liquor between
 September 2000 and a date, after 30 June 2001, prescribed under the regulations.
- (2) This Act expires on the day after the prescribed date mentioned in subsection (1).
 - *Note* After the prescribed date, low-alcohol liquor subsidy will still be payable in relation to sales by wholesale of low-alcohol liquor between 1 September 2000 and the prescribed date (see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 84).
