An Act to amend the Discrimination Act 1991

Notified under the Legislation Act 2001 on 13 June 2002 (see www.legislation.act.gov.au)

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Discrimination Amendment Act 2002.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the Discrimination Act 1991.

4 Interpretation for Act Section 4(1), new definitions of potential pregnancy and pregnancy

5 New section 5A

5A Meaning of potential pregnancy

A reference in this Act to potential pregnancy of a woman includes a reference to—

- (a) the fact that the woman is or may be capable of bearing children; and
- (b) the fact that the woman has expressed a desire to become pregnant; and
- (c) the fact that the woman is likely, or is perceived as being likely, to become pregnant.
