An Act to provide for the number of members of the Legislative Assembly

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Australian Capital Territory (Legislative Assembly) Act 2014.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

#### 3 Number of Legislative Assembly members— Self-Government Act, s 8 (2)

- (1) This Act is made for the purposes of the Australian Capital *Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988* (Cwlth), section 8 (2).
- (2) The Legislative Assembly is to consist of 25 members.
- (3) Subsection (2) applies to the Legislative Assembly constituted by members elected at a general election after the commencement of this Act.
