### Information for the applicant

Am I entitled to apply for a postal vote, or to vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre?

You are entitled to apply for a postal vote, or to vote in person at a pre-poll voting centre, if you:

- are on the ACT electoral roll: and
- expect to be unable to attend a polling place on polling day.

#### How do I apply for a postal vote?

If you wish to vote by post, complete and return this application.

#### Where do I send my application?

You can post your application to the ACT Electoral Commission, PO Box 272, Civic Square ACT 2608 or fax it to (02) 6205 0382.

#### When does the application have to be in by?

If ballot papers are to be posted overseas, the application must be received by 5:00 pm Canberra time on the Friday 8 days before polling day.

Otherwise, your application must be received by the ACT Electoral Commission by no later than 5:00 pm Canberra time on the Thursday before polling day.

#### When will I get my ballot papers?

Postal votes are despatched in the three weeks up to polling day. Your ballot papers will be sent to you as soon as possible.

## How do I vote at a pre-poll voting centre?

A written application is not required if you prefer to vote in person at any of the advertised pre-poll voting centres.

The location and opening times of pre-poll voting centres are available from the Commission's website at **www.elections.act.gov.au**.

They will also be published in local newspapers in the period leading up to polling day or phone **(02) 6205 0033** for details.

#### Information for the witness

#### Who can be a witness?

If you are in Australia, this application must be witnessed by an elector whose name appears on a Commonwealth of Australia electoral roll. If you are overseas, any person 18 years of age or older may be a witness.

A candidate for election cannot be a witness.

#### What are the duties of a witness?

As a witness you must:

- be satisfied as to the identity of the applicant;
- see the applicant sign the application;
- be satisfied that the statements contained in the application are true; and
- sign the application, add the date and your name and address.
