### Part 8 Transitional provisions

#### 289 Transitional—pt 2, div 3, subdiv D

- (1) Despite the repeal of part 2, division 3, subdivision D, the subdivision continues to apply in relation to land that, immediately before the commencement of this section, was defined land within the meaning of the subdivision and—
  - (a) was held under a lease or sublease by a person other than the Territory or a Territory authority; or

- (b) was the subject of a contract or agreement by the Executive, on behalf of the Commonwealth, for the grant of a lease to a person other than the Territory or a Territory authority.
- (2) This section expires 2 years after it commences.
