## Liquor Amendment Bill 2001

---

### **A Bill for**

An Act to amend the *Liquor Act 1975*

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2001 122B

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Liquor Amendment Act 2001*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

**3 Act amended**

This Act amends the *Liquor Act 1975*.

**4 Section 159**

*substitute*

**159 Evidence that liquids are liquor**

- (1) If an information for an offence against a provision of this Act states that a substance is liquor, the statement is evidence that the substance is liquor within the meaning of the provision.
- (2) This section has effect whether or not a sample of the liquid—
  - (a) has been taken; or
  - (b) has been given to the defendant; or
  - (c) has been subject to chemical or any other analysis.
- (3) This section does not apply to a proceeding begun before the commencement of this section.
- (4) Subsection (3) and this subsection expire 2 years after their commencement.

*Note* The expiry of a transitional provision does not end its continued effect—see *Legislation Act 2001*, s 82, def of **repeal** and s 88 (1).
