Interpretation Amendment Bill 2000

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Interpretation Act 1967*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Interpretation Amendment Act 2000*.

2 Commencement

(1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

(2) Subsection 4 (1) commences on the day on which the amendment of the *Magistrates Court Act 1930* made by the *Justice and Community Safety Legislation Amendment Act 1999* commences.

3 Insertion

After section 30AB of the *Interpretation Act 1967* the following section is inserted:

“30AC Power to determine fees, charges and other amounts

If an Act authorises or requires the determination of a fee, charge or other amount, the power includes power to determine a tax.”

4 Consequential amendments

(1) The *Magistrates Court Act 1930* is amended by omitting from the definition of *fee* in section 248 “and a tax”.

(2) The *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* is amended by omitting subsection 96 (6).
