Poisons and Drugs (Amendment) Bill 1999

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the Poisons and Drugs Act 1978

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1. Short title
- This Act may be cited as the Poisons and Drugs (Amendment) Act 1999.
 - 2. Commencement

 This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.
 - 3. Principal Act
 In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Poisons and Drugs Act 1978.
- 10 4. Advertising scheduled substances

Section 48A of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:

"(4) In subsection (1), a reference to a Schedule 3 substance shall be read as not including a reference to a Schedule 3 substance that is listed in Appendix H to the Drugs and Poisons Standard.".
