FOR

An Act to amend the Oaths and Affirmations Act 1984

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

10

- This Act may be cited as the Oaths and Affirmations (Amendment) 5 Act 1998.
 - 2. Commencement

 This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.
 - 3. Principal Act
 In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Oaths and Affirmations Act
 1984.

4. Substitution

Section 6A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted:

"6A Oath or affirmation by member of Legislative Assembly

Notwithstanding subsection 9 (1) of the Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988 of the Commonwealth, a member of the Legislative Assembly, before taking his or her seat, shall make and subscribe an oath or affirmation in accordance with the form specified in Schedule 1A.".

10 5. Schedule 1A

Schedule 1A to the Principal Act is amended-

- (a) by omitting the heading and substituting the following heading: "OATH OR AFFIRMATION BY MEMBER OF LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY";
- (b) by omitting Part I; and
- (c) by omitting the heading to Part II
