An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act 1936

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No. 3) 1998.

2. Commencement

(1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.

(2) Section 4 commences on a day fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

(3) If section 4 has not commenced before the end of the period of 6 months commencing on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*,

that provision, by force of this subsection, commences on the first day after the end of that period.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Motor Traffic Act 1936.¹

5 4. Maximum speed applicable to public streets Section 143 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "60" and

substituting "50"
