An Act to amend the Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) Act 1982

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) 5 (Amendment) Act 1995.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

10 **3.** In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Magistrates Court (Civil Jurisdiction) Act 1982.¹

(a) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:

"(2) For the purposes of paragraph (1) (d), the bailiff may enter and search any premises where the bailiff suspects the person to be, using such force as is necessary and reasonable "; and
