FOR

An Act to amend the Discrimination Act 1991

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Discrimination (Amendment) Act 5 (No. 3) 1994.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Discrimination Act 1991.

Conciliation

- **4.** Section 80 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:
- "(2) Evidence of anything said or done in the course of conciliation proceedings in relation to a complaint is not admissible—
 - (a) in subsequent proceedings under this Act; or
 - (b) in proceedings, pursuant to section 94, for the review of a direction or other decision of the Commissioner;

relating to the complaint.".
