Interpretation (Amendment) Bill 1994

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the *Interpretation Act 1967*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interpretation (Amendment) Act 1994*.

5 **Commencement**

2. (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.

10 (2) Section 4 commences on the day on which sections 9 and 28 of the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1994* commence.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Interpretation Act 1967*.¹

Meaning of certain words

4. Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (1) the following definition:

- 5 “ ‘Administrative Appeals Tribunal’ means the Australian Capital Territory Administrative Appeals Tribunal established by section 4 of the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989*.”
