Magistrates Court (Amendment) Bill (No. 2) 1993

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Magistrates Court Act 1930

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Magistrates Court (Amendment) Act 5 (No. 2) 1993.

Commencement

- 2. (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the Gazette.
- (2) The remaining provisions commence on the day on which section 33 of the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act 1993* commences.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Magistrates Court Act 1930.1

Ex parte order may be set aside

- 4. Section 23 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting from paragraph (7A) (b) "or the registration of a motor vehicle has been cancelled, or" and substituting ", the registration of a motor vehicle.": and
- (b) by omitting subparagraphs (7A) (b) (i), (ii) and (iii) and substituting the following subparagraphs:
 - "(i) to reinstate the licence;
 - (ii) to reinstate the registration of the motor vehicle; or
- 10 (iii) to cancel the suspension;".

Parking and traffic offences

- 5. Section 147A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (2) (a) "cancellation" (wherever occurring) and substituting "suspension".
- 15 Parking and traffic offences—further orders in respect of natural persons
 - 6. Section 150A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (1) (a) "cancellation" (wherever occurring) and substituting "suspension".
- 20 Parking and traffic offences—further orders in respect of bodies corporate
 - 7. Section 150B of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (1) (a) "cancellation" and substituting "suspension".
