An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act 1936

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act 1993.

Principal Act

2. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Motor Traffic Act 1936.1

Exemption for armoured security vehicles

"163P. (1) Sections 151, 152, 155, 156, 158 (other than paragraph (1) (n)) and 163F do not apply in relation to an armoured security vehicle while that vehicle is stopped or parked to facilitate the transfer of payrolls, other large amounts of money or valuable securities to or from the vehicle in the course of a business that provides an armoured security service.

"(2) In subsection (1)—

'armoured security vehicle' means a vehicle constructed, and fitted or equipped, for the secure conveyance of payrolls, other large amounts of money or valuable securities.".
