penalty units*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interpretation (Amendment) Act 1991*.

Principal Act

2. In this Act "Principal Act" means the *Interpretation Act 1967*.

Insertion

3. After section 33 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:

"Penalty units

33A. A reference in any Act or subordinate law to a number (whether fractional or whole) of penalty units shall be read as a reference to an amount of money equal to the amount obtained by multiplying by \$100 that number of penalty units."
