A Bill for

An Act to amend the National Environment Protection Council Act 1994

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1	Name of Act
	This Act is the National Environment Protection Council
	Amendment Act 2002.
2	Commencement
	This Act commences on whichever of the following happens later:
	(a) the day after its notification day;
	(b) the day the <i>National Environment Protection Council Amendment Act 2002</i> (Cwlth), schedule 1 commences.
	Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

	This Act amends the National Environment Protection Council Act 1994.

13 14 15	(2)	If the council decides that a variation does not involve a significant change in the effect of the national environment protection measure, the council must prepare—
16		(a) a draft of the proposed variation; and

21B Public consultation for minor variation (1) Refere making a minor variation to a new public consultation for minor variation.

- (1) Before making a minor variation to a national environment protection measure, the council must publish a notice—
 - (a) stating how the draft of the proposed variation and the explanatory statement may be obtained; and
 - (b) inviting submissions to the council on the proposed variation, or on the explanatory statement, within a stated period.
 - (2) The notice must—

- (a) be published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette; and
- (b) in each participating State or Territory concerned—also be published, on at least 1 day during the month when the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* notice is published, in a newspaper circulating in that State or Territory.
- (3) The period stated in each notice under subsection (1) must end not less than 1 month after the day when subsection (2) (b) has been fully complied with in all participating jurisdictions.

17 21C Council to have regard to submissions etc

- In making a minor variation to a national environment protection measure, the council must have regard to—
- (a) any submissions it receives that relate to the proposed variation or the explanatory statement; and
 - (b) whether the measure is consistent with section 3 of the agreement; and
- 24 (c) relevant international agreements to which Australia is a party; 25 and
 - (d) any regional environmental differences in Australia.

10	Review of operation of Act Section 63 (2)

(2)	The report of the review is to be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 12 months after the 5th anniversary of that commencement.
(3)	As soon as possible after the end of every 5 year period following the review under subsection (1), the council must cause a further review of the kind set out in subsection (1) to be undertaken.
(4)	The report of each further review is to be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 12 months after the end of the period to which it relates.
