A Bill for

An Act to amend the *Legislative Assembly (Broadcasting) Act 2001*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Legislative Assembly (Broadcasting) Amendment Act*
3 *2002*.

4 **2 Commencement**

5 This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

6 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
7 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

8 **3 Act amended**

9 This Act amends the *Legislative Assembly (Broadcasting) Act 2001*.

12 **7 Electronic access to proceedings given by clerk**

19 (1) The Speaker may, in writing, direct that a person be given access to
20 the recording and transmission facilities of the Legislative Assembly
21 for transmission to the person of public proceedings of the
22 Assembly or a committee of the Assembly.

23 *Note* The power to make a direction includes the power to amend or repeal it
24 (see Legislation Act, s 46 (1)).

1 (2) The Speaker must give a copy of the direction to the person.

2 (3) The direction is a disallowable instrument.

3 *Note 1* A disallowable instrument must be notified, and presented to the
4 Legislative Assembly, under the Legislation Act.

5 *Note 2* An amendment or repeal of a direction is also a disallowable instrument
6 (see Legislation Act, s 46 (2)).
