An Act to amend the Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

9 10 11		(4)	In deciding whether to appoint a person as a member, the Minister must have regard to the desirability of ensuring that there is a balance of skills, expertise and gender among the council members.
12		(5)	The Minister must not appoint a member for longer than 3 years.
13 14 15			<i>Note</i> A person may be reappointed to a position if the person is eligible to be appointed to the position (see Legislation Act, s 208 and dict, pt 1, def <i>appoint</i>).
16 17 18		(6)	The conditions of appointment of a member are the conditions agreed between the Minister and the member subject to any determination under the <i>Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995</i> .
19	32		Appointment of chair and deputy chair
20 21		(1)	The Minister may appoint a council member as chair of the council and another member as deputy chair of the council.
22 23		(2)	However, the Minister must not appoint a member of staff as chair or deputy chair.
