12 13		(2)	The employer may apply to the authority for reimbursement of an amount paid under the relevant provision.
14 15 16		(3)	The authority must pay the employer the amount paid under the relevant provision, less any amount outstanding that is payable by the employer to the authority, if—

19 20			(b) the governing board is satisfied that the amount paid by the employer was properly paid under the relevant provision.
