An Act to amend the *ACTION Authority Act 2001*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2001 164B

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *ACTION Authority Amendment Act 2001*.

3 **2 Commencement**

4 (1) This Act (other than section 5) commences on its notification day.

5 (2) Section 5 commences, or is taken to have commenced, on the
6 commencement of the *ACTION Authority Act 2001*, section 4.

7 **3 Act amended**

8 This Act amends the *ACTION Authority Act 2001*.

9 **4 New section 35A**

11 **35A Regulation-making power**

12 The Executive may make regulations for this Act.

13 *Note* Regulations must be notified, and presented to the Legislative
14 Assembly, under the *Legislation Act 2001*.

15 **5 New section 36A**

17 **36A Transferred staff**

18 (1) This section applies to a person who was—

19 (a) immediately before the commencement day a public servant
20 employed or performing duties in the business unit known as
21 ACTION in the Department of Urban Services; and

22 (b) mentioned in an instrument under section 22 (1) (Former
23 public servants); and

1 (c) mentioned in an instrument under section 36 (1) as being a
2 person who is transferred to the authority.

3 (2) For this Act, the person is taken to be a transferred employee under
4 section 22 and an employee of the authority from the
5 commencement day.

6 **6 New section 40**

8 **40 Expiry of pt 6**

9 (1) This part expires on 31 December 2003.

10 (2) To prevent doubt, it is declared that the *Legislation Act 2001*,
11 section 88 (Repeal does not end transitional or validating effect etc)
12 applies to part 6.
