

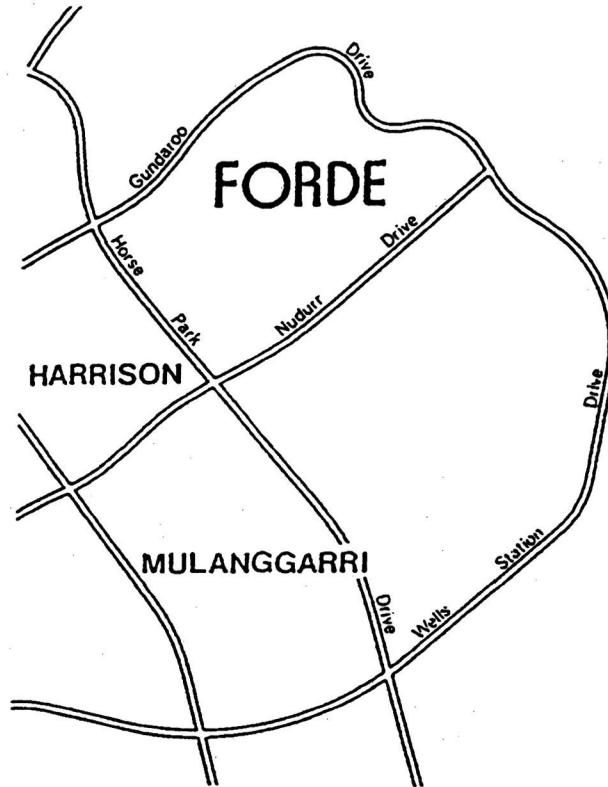
SCHEDULE 'A'

DIVISION NAME WITH REFERENCE TO ORIGIN

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
FORDE	Francis Michael Forde (1890-1983)	Politician. Born Mitchell, Queensland. He entered the Federal Parliament as a Labor member in 1922, and became Minister in the Scullin Labor Government in 1929. He was Deputy Prime Minister to John Curtin 1941-1945, Prime Minister for seven days after Curtin's death, and then Deputy Prime Minister to Ben Chifley until his defeat in the 1946 election. He then became High Commissioner to Canada 1946-1953. From August 1945 he was Minister for Defence.
