Inspection of Pressure Vessels

- 1) Steam jacketed pan having an internal diameter
 - a) not exceeding 1 metre \$27.00
 - b) exceeding 1 metre \$32.00
- 2) Other pressure vessels having an internal capacity
 - a) not exceeding 150 litres \$27.00
 - b) exceeding 150 litres but not exceeding 1,500 litres \$32.00
 - c) exceeding 1,500 litres but not exceeding 3,000 litres \$52.00
 - d) exceeding 3,000 litres \$74.00

Other

Exempted Vessels

- 1) For an inspection required to be performed on any vessel eligible for exemption, the fee payable shall be \$190.00

Single Inspections

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this paragraph, where in one day in any premises an inspection is made of:
 - a) only one boiler and no pressure vessel, or
 - b) only one pressure vessel and no boiler, and the boiler or pressure vessel inspected is one referred to in Inspection of Boilers subparagraph 2(a) and Inspection of Pressure Vessels subparagraph 1(a) and (b), and 2(a) and (b), the fee to be charged for the inspection shall be 50 percent in excess of the fee otherwise payable

Multiple Inspections

- 1) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this paragraph, where in any one day in any premises 5 or more boilers or 5 or more pressure vessels are inspected, the fee to be charged for the inspection shall be 30 percent less than the fees otherwise payable
