SUPPLEMENTARY DETERMINATION OF FEES AND CHARGES APPLICABLE IN THE LOWER COURTS AND TRIBUNALS AND EXPLANATORY NOTES

INSTRUMENT No. 208 of 2000

- 1. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2000.
- 2. Under subsection 248A(1) of the Magistrates Court Act 1930 I AMEND Determination No. 195 of 2000 by adding the following words to the text describing the matter in respect of which a fee or charge is payable at end of items 2(ii) and 2(iii) "or where no amount is in dispute" and adding the additional explanatory note at the end of item 2 "The supplementary determination of fees and charges, for the avoidance of doubt, ensures that fees can be charged in cases where no amount is in dispute, such as an application for a second hand dealers license."

Explanatory Note: The supplementary determination avoids barren arguments about whether the phrase "where the amount in dispute is \$10,000 or less" includes a case where no amount is in dispute.
