

AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY OLYMPIC EVENTS SECURITY ACT 2000

INSTRUMENT NO. 297 OF 2000

DECLARATION

No. 1 of 2000

- 1. Under section 4 of the *Olympic Events Security Act* 2000 ("the Act"), I hereby declare those events set out in Schedule A to be an Olympic event for the purposes of the Act.
- 2. This declaration is in force between 12 September 2000 and 25 September 2000.
- 3. Under s.7 of the Act, I state the statutory conditions of entry to the Olympic venue are as follows:
 - (a) person seeking to enter or in the Olympic venue shall, if asked by an authorised person, permit a search to be made of his or her personal property;
 - (b) person seeking to enter or in the Olympic venue shall, if asked by an authorised person, permit a frisk search to be made of his or her person; and
 - (c) person shall not take into or possess in the Olympic venue a prohibited item.
- 4. For the purposes of this declaration:
- (a) the time and date for each event are set out in Schedule A;

- (b) the "prohibited items" referred to above are those set out in Schedule B; and
- (c) the location of the Olympic venue for each event is as follows:

Bruce Stadium and Surrounds

All that part of the Australian Capital Territory commencing at the corner (E208121.80 N607386.26 ACT Preliminary Grid Co-ordinates) being the south-east limit of the road which forms the south-eastern frontage of Block 2 Section 30 Bruce as shown on Deposited Plan 7622 held by the Registrar-General's Office and bounded thence on the north-west by a line to the south-east corner of the roofline of the Australian Institute of Sport Indoor Arena; thence on the north-west by a line to the north-east corner of the same roof; thence on the north-east by a line to the corner between boundary line 17 and boundary line 18 shown on Sub-Lease Plan 2986 held by the Registrar-General's Office; thence on the east and the south by boundary lines 18 through to 54 inclusive to the corner between boundary line 54 and boundary line 55 shown on the above-mentioned Sub-Lease Plan; thence on the south-west by a line to the point of commencement.

5. The Olympic venue contains a restricted area.

Glass items, other than optical lenses and items containing food or beverages for infants

Bottles and cans, other than those containing food or beverages for infants Prohibited weapons and prohibited articles under the *Prohibited Weapons Act* 1996

Knives, including knives under the Crimes Act 1900

Firearms under the Firearms Act 1996

Flares, fireworks, explosives, smoke bombs, petrol and dangerous goods under the *Dangerous Goods Act* 1984

Drugs of dependence and prohibited substances under the *Drugs of Dependence Act* 1989

Liquor within the meaning of the Liquor Act 1975

Flags exceeding $1.8 \times 0.9 m$ and flag poles exceeding 1 metre in length Flags of non-participating countries

Any political, religious or race-related materials for public promotion or distribution

Balls, frisbees and similar projectiles
