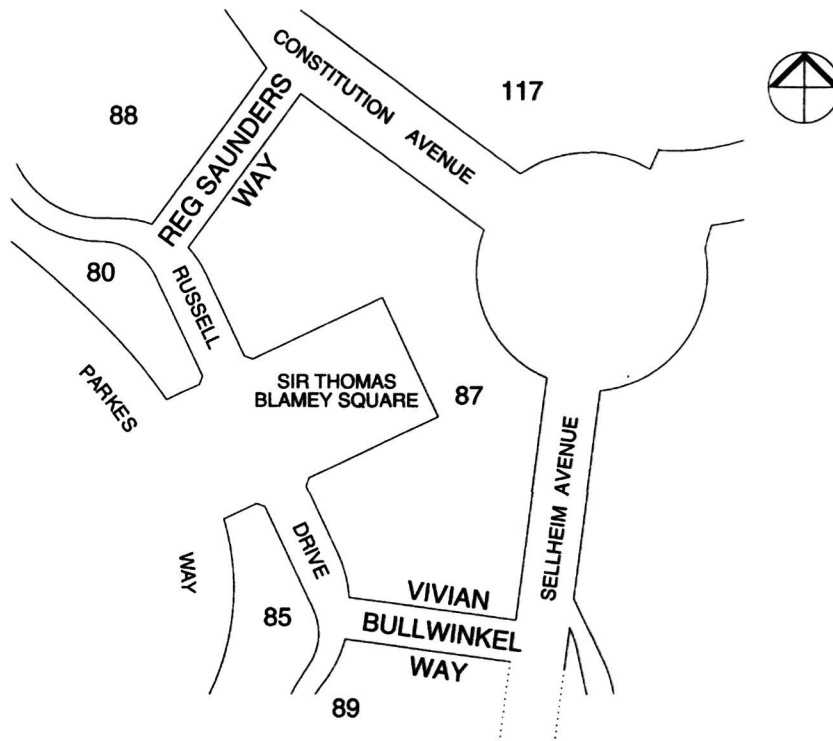

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Reg Saunders Way	Captain Reg Saunders (1920 – 1990)	MBE; Soldier; first aborigine to be commissioned an officer in the Australian Army; served with the 6th Division in North Africa, Greece and New Guinea during WWII and later in Korea; appointed to the Council of the Australian War Memorial in 1985
Vivian Bullwinkel Way	Sister Vivian Bullwinkel (1915 – 2000)	Lieutenant Colonel, MBE, OA, ARRC, - Australia's most famous wartime nurse, she was the only survivor of the infamous Banka Island massacre in Sumatra during World War II.
