Pursuant to Section 39B (2) of the *Bookmakers Act 1985*, the Commission VARIES Determination No. 50 of 1999 notified in Gazette No. S15 of 17 March 1999 as set out in the attached schedule.

Omit “and” from the end of paragraph 1.1.3.

Omit paragraph 1.1.4 and insert the following:

- “1.1.4 the Australian Wallabies play an international Rugby match at Bruce Stadium; and
- 1.1.5 a home game is played during the Canberra Cosmos participation in the National Soccer League.”

Omit paragraphs 4.2 and 4.3 and insert the following:

- “4.2 Thermal ticket printers are permitted to be used at Bruce Stadium only for bets where the contingency is determined on the same day that the ticket is issued.
- 4.3 Tickets in respect of other bets shall be in a form that will ensure that the details printed on the ticket will not deteriorate, fade or become unreadable over the period of the contingency or within a period of 28 days thereafter.”

Omit paragraph 5.2 and insert the following:

- “5.2 If the identity of the punter or the transaction cannot be clearly determined, the details of the bet and the name of the bookmaker concerned are to be forwarded to the:-
