ROAD TRANSPORT (GENERAL) ACT 1999

DECLARATION THAT THE ROAD TRANSPORT LEGISLATION DOES NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN ROADS AND ROAD RELATED AREAS

INSTRUMENT No. 202 OF 2001

Pursuant to subsection 12(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, I declare that the road transport legislation does not apply to the roads or road related areas used or impinged on by any competing vehicle participating in a 'green' special stage of the Wizard Home Loans Rally on 28 July 2001.

For this declaration, the following definitions apply:

Competing vehicle means:

Any vehicle used for participating in a 'green' special stage of the Wizard Home Loans Rally.

'Green' special stage means:

The period from the time when a special stage is declared to be active for rally competition until the time when course control for that special stage is declared closed.

Special stage means:

(a) The competitive routes for the various special stages shown on Map A, described as:

- Special stage 1 (SS1) Tidbinbilla I; and
- Special stage 5 (SS5) Tidbinbilla II;
- (b) The competitive route for the following special stage shown on Map B, described as:
- Special stage 2 (SS2) Pierces East;
- (c) The competitive routes for the various special stages shown on Map C, described as:
- Special stage 3 (SS3) Hyles I; and
- Special stage 6 (SS6) Hyles II;

(d) The competitive route for the following special stage shown on Map D, described as:

- Special stage 4 (SS4) Uriarra;
- (e) The competitive route for the following special stage shown on Map E, described as:
- Special stage 7 (SS7) East West; and
- (f) The competitive route for the following special stage shown on Map F, described as:
- Special stage 8 (SS8) Bluetts.

This declaration has effect during the competitive 'green' special stages of the Wizard Home Loans Rally on 28 July 2001. Indicative start times for vehicles participating in each 'green' special stage and indicative start control closure times for each 'green' special stage are set out in the attached Running Schedule.
