1 Name of declaration

This declaration is the *Public Health Risk (Centre for opioid detoxification using opioid antagonists) Declaration 2001.*

2 Commencement

This declaration commences on the day this declaration is notified in the Gazette.

3 Definitions

In this declaration—

building includes a part of a building, a structure, part of a structure, a temporary structure and a part of a temporary structure.

detoxification centre means a building where rapid detoxification is provided.

private centre for opioid detoxification using opioid antagonists means a building where rapid detoxification is provided by a private organisation or individual.

opioid antagonist includes naltrexone and naloxone.

rapid detoxification means the process of accelerating withdrawal from heroin (or other opioids) by the administration of an opioid antagonist.

hospital means premises that is a licensed private hospital or a public hospital.

4 Detoxification Centre—public health risk activities

It is a licensable public health risk activity to operate, manage or control a *private centre for opioid detoxification using opioid antagonists*.

5 Hospitals-not detoxification centre

A *hospital building* is not a *detoxification centre* for the purpose of this declaration and as such is exempt from the requirement to hold a public health risk activity licence.
