## Dangerous Goods (Fees) (Bushfire Emergency) Determination 2003

Disallowable Instrument DI 2003—58

made under the

Dangerous Goods Act 1975, section 46 (Determination of fees)

## 1 Application of DI—2003 No 131 to 2003 bushfire emergency

- (1) I determine that the *Dangerous Goods (Fees) Revocation and Determination* 2002, DI2002—131 does not apply to an application for a licence under the Act, section 8 (Licensing of premises) in relation to premises that—
  - (a) were damaged or destroyed by fire, or in the course of fighting fire, associated with the 2003 bushfire emergency; or
  - (b) are to replace such premises with premises of the same kind as that located on the land immediately before that emergency.
- (2) In this determination:

**2003** bushfire emergency means the bushfire emergency from 18 January 2003 to 28 January 2003.

## 2 Application of determination

This determination does not apply to work that would result in an increase in the number of depots where dangerous goods are kept on licensed premises.

## 3 Commencement

This instrument is taken to have commenced on 18 January 2003.
