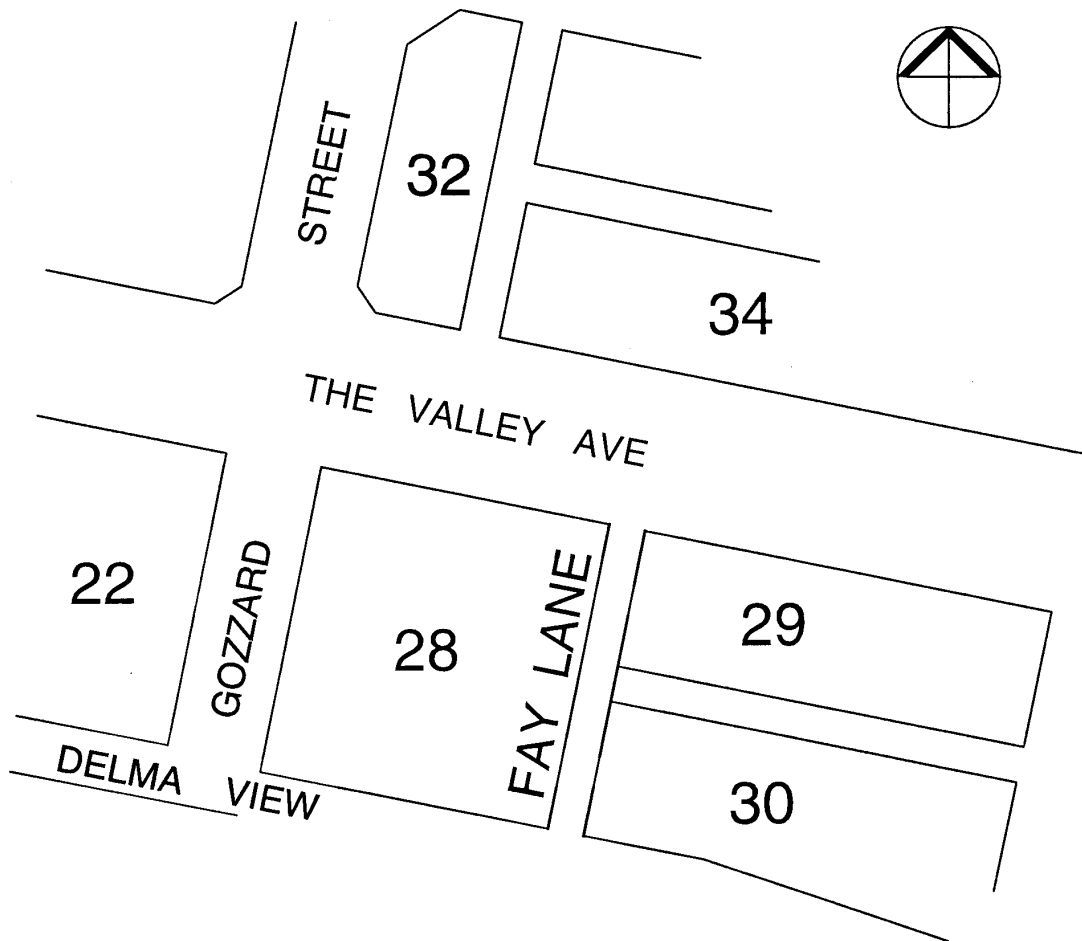
#### Division of Gungahlin: Industrialists, Aspects of Industry and Gungahlin Pioneers

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Fay Lane	Maura Fay (1958-2001)	<p>Australian Film and Television Industry</p> <p>Maura Fay was raised in Wynyard, Tasmania. Returning to Australia, after travelling in Ireland, she commenced working on the TV production <i>Prisoner</i> for Grundy Organisation. Seven years later she joined PBL Productions as head of production, and worked at different times for both Seven and Nine networks.</p> <p>Fay founded Maura Fay Casting in 1987, and at the time of her death had offices in Sydney, Melbourne, the Gold Coast, Auckland, Singapore and Los Angeles.</p> <p>She served on the boards of the Australian Theatre for Young People and the Sydney Film Festival and often attended amateur, student and community theatre productions. In 2001 the <i>Screen Producers Association of Australia (SPAA) Services to Industry Award</i> was awarded posthumously to Maura. SPAA has since decided to name the award the <i>Maura Fay Award for Services to the Industry</i> in recognition of Maura's extraordinary rich life and valued contributions to Australian film and television.</p>
