1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Gaming Machine (Warning Notices) Determination 2004*.

This instrument commences 2 weeks after the last day when it could have been disallowed (section 151(6)(a) refers).

The form and text of a Warning Notice to be displayed in a prominent position on each gaming machine installed on a licensed premises shall be one of the following:

**DON'T LET GAMBLING TAKE
CONTROL OF YOUR LIFE**

GAMBLING CAN BECOME ADDICTIVE

**EXCESSIVE GAMBLING CAN RUIN
LIVES**

**EXCESSIVE GAMBLING CAN DESTROY
FAMILIES AND FRIENDSHIPS**

**EXCESSIVE GAMBLING CAN
LEAD TO THE LOSS OF YOUR
HOME AND LOVED ONES**

**EXCESSIVE GAMBLING CAN AFFECT
YOUR HEALTH**

The minimum dimensions of a notice shall be 110mm © 25mm or 70mm © 40mm with a minimum upper case font of 20.

The form and text of the Warning Notice to be displayed in a prominent position at or near each entrance to each gaming area within a licensed premises shall be:

WARNING – GAMING AREA

**PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS ARE
NOT PERMITTED IN THE GAMING AREA**

**IF YOU HAVE A GAMBLING PROBLEM –
CONTACT THIS VENUE ABOUT AVAILABLE
HELP**

The minimum dimensions of the above notice shall be 420mm © 295mm (A3) with a minimum upper case font size of 50 for the heading and 40 for the text.
