Lotteries (Exempt Lotteries) Determination 2011 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2011–146

made under the

Lotteries Act 1964, section 6(1)(b)(i) (Exempt Lotteries)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Lotteries (Exempt Lotteries) Determination 2011 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Determination

I determine that the total value of prizes referred to under section 6(1)(b)(i) of the *Lotteries Act 1964* to be \$500.00 except where the outcome of a lottery that is a raffle is decided by the use of “Lucky Envelopes” in which case the determined total value of prizes is \$0.00.

4 Instrument Revoked

This instrument revokes *Lotteries (Exempt Lotteries) Determination No. 280 of 1996*.

In this Instrument, “Lucky Envelope” refers to the lottery raffle that is also known as “Bingo Tickets”, “Pull Tickets” or “Break Open Tickets” where letters, numbers or symbols are revealed by scratching or breaking open parts of the ticket in order to determine a winning combination.
